The John Lynch Star of the Month program recognizes middle and high school student-athletes for their accomplishments in academics, athletics, and community involvement. Each month eight winners are chosen by a selection committee at the John Lynch Foundation and are invited to attend an awards ceremony at the Denver Broncos training facility in Dove Valley. At the facility they meet John Lynch in person, receive their award, media recognition, and a behind the scenes tour of the facility.

The FFCHS JROTC Unarmed Drill Team was recognized for being selected to attend the US Army Cadet Command National Drill Team Championships on March 30, 2019. The Unarmed Drill Team was selected after competing in the 5th Brigade Drill Championships in Richmond, Virginia. The FFCHS Trojan Cyberpatriot Teams were recognized for qualifying for the National Semi-finals. They placed in the top three of the Cyberpatriot State Round of competition on January 11, 2019. Team 3 finished 1st in the state in the Gold Division. Team 1 finished 3rd in the state in the Platinum Division. The teams will compete in the National Semi-finals.
